Mothers' 1970 Chevelle "ProPane" to Premier on Hot Rod TV this Saturday

The team from Mothers Polish has another cool ride to add to its already impressive fleet of hot rods and customs. It's the ultimate Chevy muscle car, a 1970 Chevelle SS. But this build is more than just your average overhaul — it's resto-modded with pro touring in mind, and produces over 1,000 clean-burning propane-fueled horsepower without the aid of boost or nitrous.

The concept was developed by Jim Holloway of Mothers Polish, designed by Chip Foose, and brought to life at Paul Gonzalez Custom Cars, who managed the build. A talented team of expert fabricators and other friends of the Mothers family were recruited from throughout the aftermarket industry and worked tirelessly until its completion. The ProPane sports a unique tube chassis by O-Brothers, which mates to an innovative inboard pushrod coil-over suspension dampened by Penske 8300 shocks. Thinking forward, the ProPane's groundbreaking power is provided by a large-displacement Haigh Engine small block and Propane Performance Industries fuel management. Any way you look at it, the Mothers ProPane is unlike any other hi-po Chevelle.
